How it Works




Three, one-day retreats which include the majority of teaching and experiences.



Monthly gatherings to talk about where you have seen God and how you are living your faith currently, as well as opportunities to serve the community and special outings.

Retreats will be held off-site and will include your parents. We will engage in conversations, ask questions, dig into scripture, play games, enjoy nature, rest, share a meal together, and have a lot of fun. Each retreat will vary and focus on the following topics:

Who is God?

An exploration of who we say God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit is and what that means for you. We will explore God through the creeds of the church, understanding the Bible, the ways we worship, and our encounters with God through the sacraments.



What is the Kingdom of God?

An exploration of the kingdom of God and what that means to each of us. You will discover what your place and role is in the kingdom of God through the 10 Commandments, understanding prayer, what being a Lutheran means, and our Lutheran theology of Law and Gospel.



What is the Point?

An exploration of your purpose and what all of this means for your life. You will have a better understanding of what the purpose of the church is, the ways in which God calls each of us into action, and why our response to God's call leads to generosity.











Hoped for Outcomes

The ultimate hope for Beyond Confirmation is that you are confident and able to make a public affirmation of your baptism and faith. In other words, you can state what you believe, you wish to affirm your baptism, and participate in the body of Christ. We'd love to see our students do this every year!

Additionally, we hope that you can answer the following questions:



Who am I in the eyes of God?



What is my purpose?



Where and how do I belong in the kingdom of God?



Who do you say God is? Jesus? The Holy Spirit?



What does all this mean for your life now and in the future?







Life of the Church

We want you to be involved in whatever way you feel called to participate.
