


## THE DISTRIBUTION

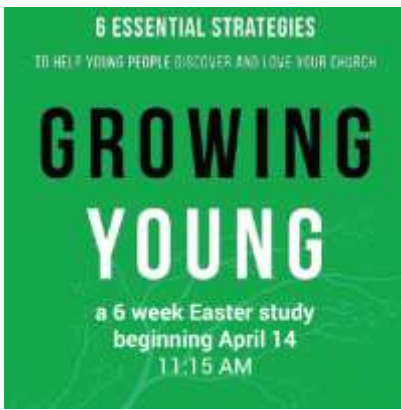

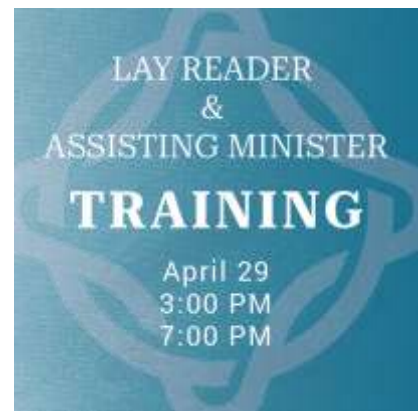
